ENTRIES: Use Foxvillage Online Entry at <https://entry.foxvillage.com/>. We will not accept any paper entries for this show.

RIDE TIMES: Riders will be notified of their tentative times the week of the show. Ride times will be finalized at noon the day prior to the show.

REFUNDS: The office fee is nonrefundable. Before closing date, entire entry minus office fee will be refunded. After closing day to day before show, refunds will be only for class fee if ride(s) can be filled. During competition, no refunds of any kind for any reason. No refunds due to acts of nature, including acts of God.

AWARDS: Ribbons to sixth place.

REQUIRED FOR HORSES: Proof of horse vaccination for equine influenza virus and equine herpes virus within six months of show must be included with entry. Proof of negative Coggins must be included with entry. Horses on grounds for schooling must also pay office fee, provide vaccine and Coggins records and wear a bridle tag. If you wish to show in the Pony division you must provide a current Pony card.

REQUIRED FOR RIDERS: Anyone on horseback must wear protective headgear with harness secured including Western Dressage riders. If you wish to show as an Amateur you must provide your Amateur card otherwise you will be placed in the Open division.

ARENA: Indoor 20 x 60-meter arena with sand mix; warm-up in large outdoor sand arena. Indoor arena only for lunging.

DIRECTIONS: From I 25 take exit 119 to the west, turn right and follow the frontage road north to the facility entrance.

VOLUNTEERS: Needed and earn credit for hours toward the chapter's generous education reimbursement grants. Also qualifies for RMDS volunteer credit. We LOVE our volunteers!!
