All classes **are not** qualifiers for RMDS Championships however, any volunteer hours may be used. (Riders or their representative must have a minimum of 4 recorded **volunteer hours** in the current competition year to be eligible for year-end awards) Inquire about **volunteer opportunities!** Contact **Volunteer Coordinator Nancy Leonard** at (719)371-0703.

Please note this is a Schooling Show and USEF rules apply only in that category of show. AVDA strongly advises your horse to be vaccinated and have had Coggins within the last 12 months. The safety of our horses is a high priority. Upload documents on EQEntries or mail in with registration. Thank you!

FEES: \$25 for each class. \$35 non-refundable Office Fee. No USEF drug fee, non-member fee or bridle tag deposit or change fee. Late entries after initial close accepted with a \$20 late fee. Show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

DAY PADDOCKS: (6 spots available): \$10.00 – first come, first serve – Email the secretary avdashows@gmail.com for your paddock. Please bring cash or check and pay for your paddock when you check in. You will receive a reserved email confirmation of paddock before show day.

RIDE TIMES: Riders will be notified of their tentative times by Wednesday before the show. Ride times will be finalized at noon the day prior to the show. Ride times will be posted on Foxvillage and emailed from avdashows@gmail.com

REFUNDS: The office fee is nonrefundable. Up until the day of the show, class fees minus office fee will be refunded. No office fee refunds due to acts of nature and God.

AWARDS: Ribbons to sixth place.

WAITLIST: A waitlist will be maintained after competition is filled and will be maintained until the final close.

REQUESTED FOR HORSES: A copy of horse vaccination for equine influenza virus and equine herpes virus within six months and copy of negative Coggins in the last year. Please include it with your entry.

REQUIRED FOR RIDERS: Anyone on horseback must wear protective headgear with harness secured. WDAA rules apply for western dressage riders.

SCHOOLING HORSES: If you wish to bring your horse for schooling purposes only, you will need to provide proof of negative Coggins and vaccinations. You will receive a bridle tag and must check in at the show office. No horses are allowed at the show without a bridle tag. (We want our horses to stay healthy!)

ARENA: Outdoor 20 x 60-meter arena with groomed sand footing; warm-up in large outdoor sand arena.

DIRECTIONS: Pathfinder Park is west of Florence on State Highway 115, north side of Hwy.
