ENTRIES: \$30.00 per class for Breed Show and USDF Intro-Fourth Level; \$40.00 per class for FEI & Freestyles; \$10.00 USDF Qualifying fee; \$30.00 office fee per horse rider combination. \$12.00 USEF drug fee; \$20.00 fee for each change after closing. There is a \$20 USEF non-member fee for each horse, rider, owner, trainer, lessee, and a \$5 breed/discipline fee!!! ENCLOSE copies of membership cards with entry: See page \_\_\_\_ for details. Make checks payable to: Autumn Hill I.E.C. \$40 bad check fee and any collection/bank fees. Send entry to secretary. Incomplete entries will be returned! You must use the 2006 RMDS Entry Form. Post entries accepted with management approval and with a \$20 fee.

**REFUNDS:** Up to closing date all fees refunded. After closing date class fees will be refunded only if class can be filled. During competition days, no refunds of any kind for any reason. After closing date the office fee is never refundable.

**TIMES:** Enclose a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope (SASE) with entry. Secretary will not call times. Tenative ride times will be mailed separately. Official ride times will be posted Friday afternoon in show office.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons to sixth place for each division. A variety of special awards will be posted. (USDF Intro tests & freestyles not eligible for high point awards.) The USDF/Dover adult Amateur Medal will be awarded to the adult amateur riding at Second Level Test 2 with the highest score of at least 58% or better who is a USDF group or participating member.

**STABLING:** Stalls with doors available. \$30 per night, no bedding provided, shavings available for purchase on grounds.

**DIRECTIONS: Autumn Hill** - From Denver take I-25 to Hwy. 36 through Boulder, AHIEC is about 8 miles north of Boulder at intersection of Hwy. 36 and Nelson Road. From North take I-25 to Hwy. 66 (Longmont)-go west to Hwy. 36 and then south 5.2 miles. AHIEC is on west side of road.
