ENTRIES: Use 2006 RMDS entry form. **Mail entries to Camille Griffin, P.O. Box 192 Castle Rock, CO 80104. Make checks payable to Sun Prairie Stable**. Entries accepted on a first come, first served basis, for the classes and levels offered. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason. Post entries accepted with \$10 late charge. Changes after close date are \$20 per change. A wait list will be established if oversubscribed. Wait list closes August 17, 2006 at noon.

DOCUMENTATION: Incomplete entries, entries without proper documentation, signatures and fees will be returned. Include PHOTOCOPIES of all required RMDS, USDF, USEF, horse, rider, trainer, owner membership/registration documents with your entry. Include a copy of a NEGATIVE Coggins test dated after Jan. 1, 2006. All out of state horses must present a valid health certificate upon arrival. Freestyle entries send copy of the highest test of the level min. 58% to be eligible to enter.

REFUNDS: Office fee is non-refundable. Entries cancelled prior to closing receive a full refund minus office fee. No refunds after close date or during show.

STABLING: LIMITED – no overnight stabling. **Day stalls only.** 12 x 12 permanent box stalls or 12x30 pipe panel runs with partial shelter attached to barn. Stallions and/or foals will be given first preference for box stalls, then, first come first served. **ABSOLUTELY NO STALLION MAY BE TIED TO A TRAILER**. Horses needing stalls will be given preference over tack stalls. No first bedding provided. Paper shavings for sale on show grounds \$6.00 per bag.

TIMES: Tentative times mailed in your SASE. **Official times posted in show office day of show, no other times are to be considered official**. Tentative schedule - Breed Show to commence in the morning, Dressage show classes to follow, probably after lunch—**tentative only!**

OFFICE HOURS: Friday, August 18 - 5:00pm - 6:00pm. Saturday, August 19 - 7:00 a.m. until 30 minutes after last class.

ARENAS: Competition Arena $-20m \times 60m$ INDOOR arena with rubber/sand mix footing. Warm-Up $-35m \times 80m$ OUTDOOR with sand footing. Lunging in ROUND PEN only. Hand walking only in competition arena at breaks.

AWARDS: Ribbons through 6th place. Ties will be broken by the judge. Dover Medal Class #109 Adult Amateur only; must include copy of USEF Adult Amateur card.

VET,FARRIER,EMT: Vet and Farrier on call – Phone numbers in show office. EMT on grounds.

CONCESSIONS: "The Caterer" on grounds limited hours. Office fee includes lunch voucher at check-in.

CONDITIONS: Show Management reserves the right to cancel, limit, or combine classes/divisions, change or add judges/officials, alter schedules and arenas as conditions warrant.

DIRECTIONS: Sun Prairie Stables 13925 E. Sun Prairie is on the right (look for the blue roof). **From Elbert:** Follow Elbert Road south to the stop sign at Hwy 24, turn right, proceed 2 miles (past Big R). Sun Prairie is on the left. **Please park in designated areas only**.
