**SHOW COMMITTEE:** The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes; limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

RMDS membership is not required to compete, but it is necessary for scores to count toward RMDS year-end awards and RMDS championship qualification. Each competitor is responsible for supplying the show management with the correct and required association numbers of RMDS for the horse, owner, and rider before the day of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not count towards RMDS year-end awards or championship qualification. The proof of these numbers must be in the form of either their actual membership/registration cards or a facsimile of them. Proof of membership must be included with entry form. All entries are taken on a first come, first served basis. Late entries will be accepted with a late fee. If the show is full, a wait list will be established on an as-received basis. Enter as soon as possible to assure entry to the show. **Only one horse-rider combination per entry form.** RMDS competitions follow USEF Dressage Competition Level 1 rules.

**ENTRIES:** Accepted electronically on a first come, first served basis, based solely on the priority of receipt of entries electronically per GR906.1. Once the competition is filled a wait list will be established and it will be based on priority of receipt electronically. **ALL COMPETITORS MUST SUBMIT WITH THEIR ENTRY CURRENT PROOF (WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF THE FIRST DAY YOUR HORSE ENTERS THE COMPETITION GROUNDS) OF EQUINE INFLUENZA AND RHINOPNEUMONITIS VACCINATION FOR ALL HORSES 7 MONTHS OF AGE OR OLDER. A CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND COGGINS MUST ALSO BE SUBMITTED.** If entry is incomplete, horse/rider combination will be placed on the wait list until required paperwork is received. Enter online at [www.horsespot.net](http://www.horsespot.net).

**Times: provisional times available at [www.horsespot.net](http://www.horsespot.net) and emailed to competitors.** Official times will be posted at the show office by noon the day before the start of the show. Numbers required at all times when horse is outside of stall or not tied to a trailer. Entry required if schooling only (non-competing horse fee and office fee).

**Freestyle entries:** You **MUST** be qualified to ride your freestyle by earning the necessary required scores (i.e. min. 63% for Training-Fourth Levels and 60% for FEI levels) at the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level from a USEF Recognized show with the exception of FEI Young Rider, Junior, and FEI Pony freestyles. Freestyles must be provided to show management on an external drive or sent digitally with your entry as an MP3 file. Freestyle sound checks will take place on Friday afternoon at 4:30pm. Other times may be arranged with prior consent by the show secretary.

Join us for **Half Halt Happy Hour** on Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup> from 4-7pm! The TD will be available for bit checks from 5-6, so bring your bridle(s)!

**REFUNDS:** All Cancellations must be made in writing either by email, fax or mail. Up through closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. Stabling not refundable after closing date. During competition days **no refunds including for Acts of God. Office fee is never refundable.**

**ARENAS:** All tests will be ridden in an indoor standard 20 x 60 meter arena with Premier Equestrian footing. Warm-up area is a large outdoor arena with pea gravel and sand footing. An outdoor round pen is available for lunging with the same footing as outdoor arena. Arena photos are available at [onthebitdressage.com/gallery](http://onthebitdressage.com/gallery). Arenas worked throughout show. **Show arena open for schooling Friday after set up, 1-6pm.**

**AWARDS:** Prize & ribbon to first place; ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup> place. High Point Awards.

From Highway 287 (Fort Collins): About 16 miles north of the WY/CO border, turn Right onto Vista Grande Way (past The Buttes entrance sign). Drive 1.3 miles on Vista Grande Way, then turn Left to the show facility – follow the Wolfe Ranch Arena sign.
