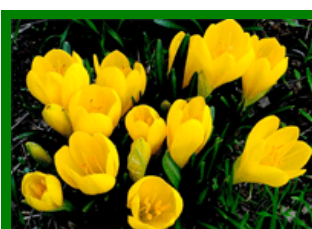

Christoph Hess: Clinician for Upcoming Professionals Clinic

Christoph Hess was born on Christmas Eve 1950 in Delmenhorst, Northern Germany. He says he was "infected" with the horse virus when he was only 8 years old. He started at the German FN (German Equestrian Federation) as an assistant in the education department.

Christoph holds a German instructor license as well as a FEI judging license. You can find more information on his [Facebook Page](#) (this one is in English). He has worked at the German FN since 1978 in numerous roles, he also was in charge of the Bundesleistungszentrum (BLZ) in Warendorf. Germany has specific training facilities for different Olympic disciplines. The BLZ in Warendorf is designed for riders of all disciplines, as well as vaulters and carriage drivers.

Christoph has authored several books, there are also some DVDs. As best as I can tell they have not been translated into English. He holds a Masters degree in teaching with emphasis on teaching adult learners. One of his major roles in the FN is the development of new courses for judges, riding instructors and officials. He travels within Germany and worldwide to hold seminars, clinics and conferences about riding with an emphasis on dressage and eventing.
